The Board of Directors has made the decision to mow or burn the native grass areas twice per year. Once in the winter and once in the summer. In addition, we will keep areas in front of several tees and near cart paths trimmed on a more frequent basis. The cost of this additional maintenance will be tracked and will help determine plans for future years.
